TERMS OF PAYMENT

Non-refundable registration fee of \$500.00 per student must accompany the signed Payment Agreement and the Registration Schedule. Your payments must be received by **June 15, 2011** regardless of which method of payment is selected. Tuition and registration fees will fully cover the cost and value of HALB's religious and secular educational programs. Students will not be admitted to class or permitted to graduate unless all fees are paid in full. **Transportation (if applicable) is paid directly to the bus company.**

METHOD OF PAYMENT

You **MUST** select one of the payment options listed below:

1. Pre-pay the entire amount by August 1, 2011
2. Three equal post-dated checks (Aug 1, Dec 1, March 1)
3. Five equal post-dated checks (August 1, October 1, December 1, 2011, February 1 and April 1, 2012)
4. Direct Debit from your checking or savings account (see enclosed form) from August through May.
