TERMS OF PAYMENT

Non-refundable registration fee of \$500.00 per student must accompany the white copy of the Registration Schedule and the white copy of the signed Registration Agreement and Payment Schedule. Your payments must be received by **June 1, 2008** regardless of which method of payment is selected. Tuition and registration fees will fully cover the cost and value of HALB's religious and secular educational programs. Students will not be admitted to class or permitted to graduate unless all fees are paid in full. **Transportation (if applicable) is paid directly to the bus company.**

METHOD OF PAYMENT

2. Three post-dated checks (**August 1, Dec. 1, March 1**)
3. **Direct Debit** from your checking or savings account (see enclosed form) from August through May.
